Misconduct of any sort or a decline in academic performance prior to your matriculation at Rice may be grounds to rescind your offer of admission. Any modification to the course schedule you put forth in your application must be approved in advance by the Office of Admission. To complete your enrollment, we must receive an official final transcript from your high school. Please ask your counselor to forward this information to us as soon as it is available.
